New in 2010: Cowboy 22 at WWWB

This year, Wounded Knee will be sponsoring a WWWB Cowboy 22 shoot at the Holmen Rod and Gun on the Sunday after our regular monthly cowboy shoots. These shoots are meant to be a fun time for all, to make a social event of the weekend with camping at the HRGC grounds, and to have shooting on both days of the weekend. The Cowboy 22 shoots will be great for new shooters or for people who just want to try out CAS, but don't have the right guns for regular cowboy shooting. Plus it's a cheap way to practice (22 ammo is less expensive, right?). The shoots will start in May for sure, possibly in April pending the weather. There will be no June Cowboy 22 shoot as that Sunday is the NCOWS sponsored match.

There will be no charge for the Cowboy 22 shoot, but we will have a collection bucket for donations to the Talking Buffalo Memorial Youth Gun Fund. We want to continue Talking Buffalo's passion to encourage young shooters to enjoy our shooting sports!

Load Up! Round Count to Exceed 100 Pistol/Rifle!

You may have noticed that for a number of years most monthly matches at the WWWB held the total pistol and rifle round count under 100, even on six stages. Well, no more! Plan on needing 10 rifle and 10 pistol on each stage from now on, although there will likely be the occasional 9 or 8 rounder, or a reload here and there to take it up to 11. Shotgun will run four plus per stage too, so be ready! Shooting is good, more shooting is better.

Cowboy 22 Rules

Cowboy 22

Cowboy attire shall be worn at all times. There will be 2 classes: 1) 2 single action revolvers. Shooters will engage targets as written in the stage. 2) 1 single action revolver. Shooters will forego the second pistol targets of the stage. Rifles will be .22 lever action or exposed hammer pumps. Rifles will be loaded as per the course and be staged with an empty chamber. Shotguns will be 12 gauge or smaller, side by side, hammered pump, or lever action. Shotguns will be staged open and empty. Knockdown targets must be hit but do not have to go down if there is a clean hit. All other CAS safety rules apply.

Cowboy 22 Wild Bunch—For Fun Shoots (Regular WWWB Wild Bunch Rules Apply to Monthly Wild Bunch Matches)

Cowboy attire shall be worn at all times. Again 2 classes: 1) Semi-auto pistol with 10 round magazine or extra magazine. 1911 Conversions, Ruger Marks, Buckmarks, etc. Shooter will engage the same targets as 2 single action revolvers. 2) Double action revolvers will be loaded with 5 rounds each and engage the same targets. Rifles will be .22 lever action, pump, or bolt holding 10 rounds or reloaded as per the course. Rifles will be staged with an empty chamber. Shotguns will be 12 gauge or smaller, pump, lever, or side by side. These do not have to have an exposed hammer. Shotguns can be loaded as the stage permits and staged with an empty chamber. (side by sides can be staged OPEN with rounds in the chamber). Knockdown targets must be hit but do not have to go down if there is a clean hit. All other CAS safety rules apply.

We would like to encourage more shooters to participate in Cowboy 22. if you have a .22 that you would like to shoot, bring it along (NO semi-auto rifles). If you have only one double action revolver, you could shoot your second with a single action. We may have to offer more or less classes of shooters as we go along, as this is a learning experience for us as well.
